LOCAL BLM MAILING ADDRESS CHANGES

People corresponding with the U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Burns District Office should begin using the new mailing address which resulted from the upgrade of the 911 emergency telephone system, reports District Manager Tom Dyer.

All correspondence sent to the local BLM office should be addressed as follows:

Dyer says the U.S. Postal Service will continue to forward mail using the old address for 1-year after the change was made. However, the office is already in the process of converting its mailings to the new one and has sent information on the change to constituents who are on a variety of mailing lists.

Dyer notes patrons may continue to use the Burns District's e-mail address (**or020mb@or.blm.gov**) which is unaffected by the postal address change.
