**Red Knoll/Clover Flat Restoration
Environmental Assessment
(EA#OR-010-2003-01) and
Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI)**

The Lakeview Resource Area, Bureau of Land Management (BLM) proposes to treat scattered infestations of medusahead rye (a noxious weed), prevent the spread of medusahead rye into new areas, and restore sage-grouse habitat invaded by medusahead rye. Treatments on adjacent private lands by willing landowners will be included in the project using federal funds. The proposed project area covers approximately 269,000 acres within the Chewaucan watershed located in south central Lake County, Oregon.

The EA and FONSI have been prepared to document the impacts of the proposed action.
