Planning Area Boundary Change

The planning area for the Upper Deschutes Resource Management Plan has been expanded by about 49,000 acres of which about 22,000 acres are managed by the BLM. The additional area is located south of Prineville Reservoir and was included after reviewing comments about the proposed plan. (see Map on back)


