- BLM Grazing Management Categories \*\*\*
  - 1) Exclusion - Areas where no grazing will be authorized on public land and/or areas where private landowners do not graze
  - 2) Campsite Exclusion - Specific campsite areas where no grazing will be authorized
  - 3) Rest (non-use) - Areas where no grazing will be authorized on a temporary basis. Typically 3 to 5 years. After the rest period, managed grazing would be authorized consistent with either category 4 or 5
  - 4) Managed Grazing (2000 cfs Exclusion) - Areas where grazing will be authorized, but a special seasonal limitation applies that limits livestock use to a time when river flows are above 2000 cubic feet per second (cfs). The riparian zones are typically under water and have detritus exclusion from grazing
  - 5) Other Managed Grazing - Areas where grazing will be authorized with riparian oriented objectives
  - 6) Private Lands - Areas of predominantly private ownership where grazing management is not directed by its plan
