Advisory Group to Spokane BLM District to Meet January 23

The Bureau of Land Management's Eastern Washington Resource Advisory Council (RAC) will meet Friday, January 23 at the Spokane BLM District office, 1103 North Fancher, in Spokane Valley, Washington. The meeting will begin at 9 a.m. and is scheduled to adjourn at 4:00 p.m. The entire meeting is open to the public and will provide time for public comment at 10:30 a.m. Agenda items include the proposed rule to amend BLM's livestock grazing regulations, the advisory council's work plan for 2004, and a land exchange update.

The Eastern Washington Resource Advisory Council is comprised of 15 members from a variety of backgrounds who are appointed by the Secretary of the Interior. The council reviews overall planning and proposed activities on public land in eastern Washington and makes recommendations to the BLM.
