**Changes to Regulated Fire Closures on BLM Lands**

Some regulated fire restrictions on public lands managed by the Bureau of Land Management's (BLM) Spokane District are being changed due to cooler weather conditions. Effective at 12:01 a.m. on Saturday, September 29, campfires will be allowed in improved fire rings in the following BLM campgrounds: Hog Lake, Twin Lakes, Coffeepot, Pacific Lake, Boundary (picnic area), Yakima River Canyon, Split Rock, and Chopaka Lake.

Scott Boyd, Fire Management Officer at the Spokane District BLM, says that wood cutting areas are open on a case-by-case basis. For further information, call the Spokane Bureau of Land Management at 509-536-1200.
