An Environmental Assessment and proposed Finding of No Significant Impact have been prepared for a proposed right-of-way to authorize the continued use and maintenance of an existing primitive dirt road crossing public lands in Asotin County, Washington. The location of the road is along the Grande Ronde River about nine miles above its confluence with the Snake River.
