### 1. INTRODUCTION

This studies objective was to construct a hypothesized distributors map, potential movement corridors and confirm wolverine presence in the Seven Devils Mountains.

### 2. CONCLUSION

*“Wolverine individuals may move from the Seven Devils mountains to the Wallowa and Blue Mountains and then to the Cascades and back. Scattered sightings in unlikely habitat between likely habitats suggest these movements. Wolverine presence was confirmed in the Seven Devils Mountains.”*  
This is a hypothesis and very likely.

### 3. STUDY ADEQUACY

Information is very limited and this species population very dispersed making it not much more than speculation about distribution and presence of wolverine.
