**FREE WILD HORSE MANURE TO BE AVAILABLE**

The U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM) will be making wild horse manure available for pick-up from the Burns Wild Horse Corrals on Saturday, May 17, 2003. The Horse Corrals, located on Highway 20 at Milepost 122, will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for open-top pickups and trailers which will be loaded with a front-end loader on a first-come, first-serve basis. There is no set limit on the amount of wild horse manure that can be obtained during the day; however, the offer does not apply to commercial haulers.

PLEASE NOTE: This will be the only day in 2003 on which wild horse manure will be available to the public.
