### **HOST NEEDED AT PAGE SPRINGS CAMPGROUND ON STEENS MOUNTAIN**

The U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Burns District is in immediate need of a campground host for Page Springs Campground, near the base of Steens Mountain in southeast Oregon. Located just south of the Malheur National Wildlife Refuge and adjacent to the Donner und Blitzen River at 4,200 feet elevation, Page Springs Campground has 31 campsites, a day use area and hiking trails, and is visited often by people who love to bird watch, fish, hike, and view the surrounding areas of Steens Mountain.

To qualify for the host assignment, one must enjoy the outdoors and living in a secluded camping environment, be able to communicate with and assist recreational visitors, be in good health, and enjoy talking with travelers about outdoor recreation opportunities in the area. Hosts must provide a trailer, camper or motor home, must be willing to stay at the site for a minimum of 1-month, and are expected to work weekends and holidays with the option of two mid-week days off. The BLM will provide a free host site, water, electricity, garbage collection, and a daily subsistence per individual or as a couple as funding allows.

Additional hosting opportunities may be available at Fish Lake and South Steens Campgrounds on Steens Mountain.
