LOG EXPORT AND SUBSTITUTION RESTRICTIONS: All timber offered for sale hereunder is restricted from export from the United States in the form of unprocessed timber and is prohibited from being used as a substitute for exported private timber.

CRUISE INFORMATION: With respect to merchantable trees of all species in all cruise strata: the average DBHOB is 11.8 inches; the average gross merchantable log contains 39 bd. ft.; the total gross volume is approximately 2100 m. bd. ft.; and 94% recovery is expected. The average DBHOB for Douglas-fir is 10.9 inches; and the average gross merchantable log contains 35 bd. ft. None of the total sale volume is salvage material. The following cruise method was used for volume determination:

LOCAL VOLUME TABLE: Timber volumes have been cruised using the local volume table system to select sample trees. The Douglas-fir sample trees were cruised using the Flewelling volume equation or form class tables for estimating board foot volumes of trees in 16-foot logs. Other species were cruised using form class tables for estimating board foot volumes of trees in 16-foot logs. The volumes are then expanded to a total sale volume.

CUTTING AREA: Eight (8) units totaling approximately 183 acres must be partial cut.

ACCESS: Access to the sale area is provided via: Bureau of Land Management, County and State controlled roads.

ROAD USE & MAINTENANCE: Refer to Exhibit E Summary attached. Operator maintenance required on 7.3 miles of road.

DURATION OF CONTRACT: Will be 36 months for cutting and removal of timber. The contract will contain special stipulations regarding logging, road construction, road use and maintenance, fire prevention, hazard reduction and logging residue reduction, log export and substitution, optional scale check of lump sum sales, equal opportunity in employment, cultural resource protection, and sensitive, threatened, or endangered plants or animals.

CRUISE INFORMATION: With respect to merchantable trees of all species in all cruise strata: the average DBHOB is 30.8 inches: the average gross merchantable log contains 281 bd. ft.; the total gross volume is approximately 556 m. bd. ft.; and 72% recovery is expected. The average DBHOB for Douglas-fir is 30.8 inches; and the average gross merchantable log contains 281 bd. ft. Approximately 100% of the total sale volume is salvage material. The following cruise methods were used for volume determination:

100% CRUISE: The timber volumes were based on a 100% cruise using form class tables for estimating board foot volume of trees in 16-foot logs.

ECONOMY GRADE RECOVERY: Lumber recovery studies used in determining realization values indicate an approximate recovery of 4.3% economy grade from the total volume of Douglas-fir in this sale. This recovery estimate is based on the assumption that the total Douglas-fir volume is sawn. The estimated Douglas-fir 32' log volume shown above has been reduced by 4.3%.

CUTTING AREA: Two (2) units totaling 10 acres.

ACCESS: Access to the sale area is provided via: Bureau of Land Management, County and State controlled roads.
