Finding of No Significant Impact  
for EA #OR-014-96-04

The Bureau of Land Management, Lakeview District, Klamath Falls Resource Area, has analyzed the following proposals and their alternative related to:

- salvage and thinning treatments involving up to five timber sales,
- treatments continuing for up to five years
- the salvage of up to 15 MMBF

Based on the information in the EA, it is my determination that none of the alternatives analyzed constitutes a significant impact affecting the quality of human environment greater than those addressed in the:

- Klamath Falls Resource Management Plan/EIS (June 2, 1995).
- Final Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (FSEIS) on Management Habitat for Late-Successional and Old Growth Forest Related Species Within the Range of the Northern Spotted Owl (also known as the Northwest Forest Plan), (April 13, 1994).
- Klamath Falls Resource Area Fire Management EA #OR-014-94-09 (June 10, 1994).
- Klamath Falls Resource Area Integrated Weed Control Plan, EA #OR-014-93-09 (July 21, 1993).

Impacts to the environment would be similar to or less than those disclosed in the above mentioned documents. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement is unnecessary and will not be prepared.
