

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT (FONSI)  
for the  
Amendment to Road Right of Way for Boise Cascade Environmental Assessment  
#OR- 118-02-001

The Amendment to Road Right of Way for Boise Cascade environmental assessment (EA) can be obtained at the Medford District Office. Specifically, the action includes amending the Right-of-Way and Road Use Agreement (M-660) and O&C Logging Road Right-of-way Permit (M-660), Serial # OR - 48747-FD with Boise Cascade Corporation, for the purpose of constructing, using, and maintaining approximately **300** feet of new road and use of BLM roads from point of new construction back to the Grave Creek Road, #34-5-10.


The following critical elements have been analyzed and would not be significantly affected by this project: air quality, areas of critical environmental concern, historical and cultural resources, Native American religious sites, prime or unique farmlands, flood plains, threatened or endangered species, known hazardous waste areas, water quality, wetlands, wild and scenic rivers, wilderness and energy development, production and distribution.

FONSI

Based on the analysis presented in EA #OR-118-02-001, I find that the actions included in Alternative 1 will not have any significant impacts on the human environment. Further, no effects noted in the EA exceed those already described in the Final Medford District Proposed Resource Management Plan and Environmental Impact Statement. No environmental impact statement, therefore, would be required.
