



Wildfires play a prominent role during much of the year in the Pacific Northwest. People living near open range and forested lands need to prepare in advance for a wildfire near their home.

Construct or remodel your home using fire-resistive materials, and consider these helpful tips:

- √ Create a lean, green, defensible space of at least 30 feet around your home.
- √ Cut lower level tree limbs and shrubs to keep a ground fire from climbing into the tops of trees and onto your roof.
- √ Store firewood away from your house and adjoining fences and wood decks.
- √ Prepare and practice an evacuation plan for your family.
