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



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THE CAMPFIRE




Pour on Water



Extinguish by pouring water on embers

Stir Apart




Stir until embers are out and cold to the touch




Drown again with Water

Return site to original condition and **MAKE SURE FIRE IS DEAD OUT**



PREPARING FOR THE TRIP



- Are Fire Restrictions in Effect?
- Obtain Good Maps of the Area.
- Are Wildfires Burning in your Hunt Area?
- Have Adequate Source of Heat, Light and Fuel for Cooking


PACK-IN / PACK-OUT

Leave Camp Site as Natural as Possible




ON THE ROAD


- Be Aware of Travel and Road Conditions.
- Do Friends or Relatives Know where you will be Hunting?
- Watch for Fire Prevention Messages.
- Carry a Cell Phone if possible.
- Carry an AM/FM Radio for Weather and Fire Information.



CAMPING EQUIPMENT



- Cool Stoves, Lanterns and Heaters before Refueling.
- Keep Stoves, Lanterns and Heaters away from Combustibles.
- Store Flammable Liquid Containers in a Safe Location.
- Follow Manufacturers Instructions for use.



SELECTING A CAMPSITE

- Be easy on the land.
- Use existing campsite when ever possible.
- Think Safety.
- Size, Keep small.
- Water.
- Terrain.



VEHICLE OPERATION

- Don't Drive or Park in Dry Grass.
- Ride only where Permitted.
- Minimize impact on land-Ride SMART.
- Make sure ATV has an approved Spark Arrester.




- Wear protective equipment

BUILDING A SAFE CAMPFIRE




Safe Site



Build in a clear area and keep the fire small.


Consider wind direction and dry conditions.

Gather Fuel




Keep firewood a safe distance away from the campfire.

No campfire in or near a tent.

Lay the Fire


VEHICLE INSPECTION

- Inspect Vehicle Spark Arrester.
- Make sure Vehicle is free of litter on the under side.
- Carry a Fire Extinguisher.
- Make sure Catalytic Converters are operational.





SELECTING A CAMPSITE

- Keep Camp or Warming Fires Small.
- Keep Tent well away from Campfire Location.
- Know Camping Regulations.



HAVE FIRE SAFETY EQUIPMENT AVAILABLE



TARGET PRACTICE

- Don't shoot tracer bullets.
- Be cautious with black powder weapons in dry conditions.
- No target practice into metal or rock backstops.
- Make sure target range area is free from fire after target shooting.




OPERATION RESPECT
