KIDS with FIRE

The majority of child-set fire incidents are the result of a child's curiosity, ready access to matches and lighters, lapses in supervision and a lack of understanding about fire.

Parents can do their part by following these tips:

- Keep matches and lighters stored in a place not known or in view by your children.
- Talk to your child about the dangers of fire.
- If your child expresses what you consider to be too much interest in fire, contact your local fire department.
