Botanical Hike

Roseburg, Ore. – The Roseburg District of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is inviting the public to participate in a Botanical Hike at 10:00 AM on Saturday, May 5, 2001 at Wolf Creek Falls. A BLM Botanist will lead the hike and identify plants and trees along the way.

This is a moderate hike and will take approximately 1 hour to reach the falls and 20-30 minutes to return to the trail head parking area at your own pace. Participants are encouraged to leave pets at home, dress for the weather, wear sturdy boots, bring water and possibly a picnic lunch. To get to Wolf Creek trail head from Roseburg, travel to Glide via Highway 138, turn right on Little River Road (County Road 17), and travel 10.7 miles to the trail head parking area and foot-bridge.
