**Project Wood Help
Wood Choppers to the Rescue**

Roseburg, Ore. – The 13th Annual Project Wood Help will happen this Saturday starting at 7 AM at Sun Studs in Roseburg. The Roseburg District of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) works every year to provide split fuel wood for folks in need.

Sun Studs is allowing the use of their yard and is also donating 5 cords of wood. Roseburg Forest Products will be donating two trucks loads of wood. Frank Zable will be donating a truck load of hardwood. A1 Rental, South Umpqua Rental and Tex Cooper will be loaning some wood splitters and the Veterans Administration will be loaning a dump truck. Pepsi Cola and Coca Cola will be donating drinks for the workers.

BLM employees will start at 7 AM and work through the morning sawing, splitting, and delivering fuel wood to people in need.

“Many folks come together to lend a hand to those neighbors in need. Here at the BLM we are grateful for the donations of wood, equipment, and refreshments and to work along side so many generous and caring people”, says E.Lynn Burkett, Public Affairs Officer for the BLM.
