The RAC needs You

Roseburg, Ore – The Roseburg District of the Bureau of Land Management is seeking applicants for the Resource Advisory Committee to fill permanent positions in interest category 1 and 3 and alternate positions in category 1, 2 and 3.

Qualifications for Category 1 include:

- Represents organized labor or;
- Represents developed outdoor recreation, off highway vehicle users, or commercial recreation activities or;
- Represents energy and mineral development interests or;
- Represents the commercial timber industry or;
- Holds Federal grazing permits, or other land use permits within the area for which the committee is organized.

Qualifications for Category 2 include:

- Represents a nationally recognized environmental organizations or;
- Represents regionally or locally recognized environmental organizations or;
- Represents dispersed recreational activities or;
- Represents archaeological and historical interests or;
- Represents nationally or regionally recognized wild horse and burro interest groups.

Qualifications for Category 3 include:

- Someone who holds a State elected office or their designee or;
- Someone who holds county or local elected office or;
- Represents American Indian tribes within or adjacent to the area for which the committee is organized or;

Are school officials or teachers or;
Represent the affected public at large.

A person may nominate themselves or someone that they know. The Resource Advisory Committee consists of 15 members and 6 alternates represents a wide variety of interests.
