

**Decision Record
for
CANTON CREEK RESTORATION
EA OR-104-98-01**

An interdisciplinary (ID) team of the Swiftwater Resource Area, Roseburg District, Bureau of Land Management has analyzed the proposed **Canton Creek Restoration Project**. This analysis and the "Finding of No Significant Impact" (FONSI) was documented in Environmental Assessment (EA) No. OR-104-98-01. The proposed action involves the decommissioning of approximately 4.9 miles of road in the Canton Creek Watershed. This project is located in Sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 24 and 25; T24S R1W; and Section 25, T25S R1W; W.M. The thirty day public review and comment period was completed on December 25th, 1997. No comments were received as a result of public review.

Decision:

It is my decision to implement Canton Creek Restoration Project and the decommissioning of approximately 4.9 miles of existing road. This work will be accomplished through "Jobs in the Woods" funding and will occur between May 15th and October 15th, 1998.

Decision Rationale:

The proposed Action is selected for the following reasons:

1. The Proposed Action implements the need for watershed restoration projects in a key watershed.
2. The Proposed Action will result in a reduction of the miles permanent roads within the watershed.

Monitoring:

Monitoring of these projects will be performed by inspections during the implementation phase and by subsequent inspections by Area personnel as needed.
