# WASHINGTON & OREGON RECREATION PASS

## *More Pass, More Play!*

***Now your Golden Eagle Passport or National Parks Pass with a Golden Eagle Hologram can be worth much more. Increase your value by adding the Washington & Oregon Recreation Pass for access to Federal and state recreation sites in Oregon and Washington.***

### **What are the benefits?**

With the Washington and Oregon Recreation Pass you get access to:

- 26 **Oregon State Parks** charging a day-use fee.
- 20 participating **Washington State Parks** charging a daily vehicle parking fee.
- 6 **Army Corps of Engineers** sites located in Washington and Oregon charging facility use fees.

The Golden Eagle Passport and the National Parks Pass with a Golden Eagle Hologram provide nationwide access to all **National Forest, National Park Service, Bureau of Land Management, and US Fish and Wildlife Service** sites charging entrance fees.

With the Washington & Oregon Recreation Pass:

- Vehicle and occupants are admitted no extra charge
- A variety of outdoor recreation opportunities such as day-use recreation sites including picnic sites, boat ramps, trails, trailheads, visitor centers, and parking are available without additional charge.
- Services for which an additional fee is charged such as: overnight camping, specialized interpretive services, boat ramps and moorages, or concessionaire services are not included.
- This pass is not replaceable, refundable, or transferable.

### **How much does it cost?**

The total cost is **\$85**: \$65 for the Golden Eagle Passport and \$20 for the additional benefits of the Washington & Oregon Recreation Pass. The pass is valid for 12 months from the date of purchase, or upon expiration of the federal pass, whichever is earlier.



## Can a visitor who already has a Golden Eagle Passport or a National Parks Pass with a Golden Eagle Hologram purchase this add-on?

**YES!** The Washington & Oregon Recreation Pass may be sold to anyone who has a valid Golden Eagle Passport or National Parks Pass with Golden Eagle Hologram. The Washington & Oregon Recreation Pass will have the same expiration date as the federal passes.

## Where can a visitor obtain this pass?

Any federal office in Washington or Oregon that sells the Golden Eagle Passport or hologram will also sell the Washington & Oregon Recreation Pass. It may also be purchased online at [www.naturenw.org](http://www.naturenw.org) or by calling 1-800-270-7504.

## Can the Golden Age or Access Passport holder purchase this add-on for their lifetime passes?

The Washington & Oregon Recreation Pass is valid only with the Golden Eagle or National Parks Pass with Golden Eagle Hologram. Since it is an annual pass, Golden Age and Access cardholders will NOT be eligible to purchase this pass as an add-on to their lifetime passports.

## Why is this pass being offered?

The Washington & Oregon Recreation Pass is designed to provide value to users of lands managed by multiple agencies for their outdoor recreation activities. It is intended to provide a convenient, cost-effective alternative to the purchase of multiple-agency passes.

## How does a visitor determine which pass they need?

Visitors must decide whether the pass will be of value to them by considering what recreation lands they intend to use and the cost of purchasing multiple passes if they intend to visit lands managed by several agencies. A chart has been developed to guide the visitor in making this decision.

## Where does the revenue from recreation pass sales go?

Each agency uses the majority of funds to operate and maintain the recreation facilities and services you use and enjoy!
